How Do I Test My Shop And Set It Live?

When setting up your Shop in the SportsTG system, we recommend that before you set it to **Live**, that you process Test transactions to ensure that your system is set up exactly as you would like it to display to your customers.

To do so, go to **Shop** in the Console, and then click on the **Shop** button. This will take you to your Shop page.

Once you get onto your Shop, go through and purchase items as if you were a customer of your organisation. You can use the Test Credit Card Details to complete payment.

Once you have finished testing your Shop, you can now set the Credit Card Gateway to Live.

This can be done by going to Shop and then Shop Options.

Click on Activate Credit Card Gateway, this will give you a Confirmation message to confirm that you want to activate the gateway. Click on

Activate Gateway and this will switch your Portal to Live.

You can now use the Shop link on your Website to start selling products to customers online.

Please Note: All Test Transactions will be *removed* from the system when you switch your Credit Card Gateway to Live. You should not start entering actual Shop transactions into the system until *after* the system has been switched to Live.
